Oni Communications wins Video Surveillance of the Ministry of Education

Lisbon, 29th January 2009 - Yesterday, 28th January, Oni Communications received the order from the Ministry of Education which formalise the award of the tender for the implementation of the electronic physical security system for public schools with 2nd and 3rd basic and secondary education cycles.

The duration of the operating agreement is for 3 years, with 4 phases of implementation of the solution in the functional and equipment components, and in 2009 it should have a financial impact in the order of 15€ million.

For Xavier Rodriguez-Martin, CEO of Oni Communications, **“it was with great satisfaction that we received the award of this contract, taking into account our objective and determination to foster and participate in the modernisation of the public sector. The implementation of an electronic security system is of particular importance in the current economic and social context, therefore we shall contribute with all our know-how, professionalism and dedication to ensure the success of this project”**.

Oni Communications will be responsible for the supply, installation, maintenance and support of an electronic security system in approximately 1200 schools, from the North to the South of the country. The services to be provided involve the acquisition of security and remote monitoring services, supply, installation and configuration of equipment, training on its use, monitoring and support of the remote and local solution.
